Donald Anderson, a member of Barry Green's "Year of the Student" ticket, has been president of the LSU-NO-NAACP for two years. Under his leadership the organization has gained the distinction of being voted the outstanding college chapter of the

NAACP. Anderson is also a member of the Presidents Council, the Young Democrats, the Separation Committee, and the Campus Americans for Democratic Action.



Louisiana State University, New Orleans (University of New Orleans), described as the "first racially integrated public university in the South", recognized its first Civil Rights student organization in the late-1960's, the *LSUNO College Chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP)*. I was president of the organization its first two years.

During that time, our Chapter was recognized as *The Outstanding College Chapter of the NAACP* in the nation and I received *LSUNO Outstanding Student Service Award* for our efforts. Our work included initiatives to increase student enrollment, diversification of the curriculum and faculty, celebration of Black History Month, community service, activism, non-violent protest job discrimination, and get out-to-vote campaigns. A Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) field agent interview helped me to realize how some others saw our work!

Dianne and I were dating then; as always, she was there working along with me to promote our civil rights agenda.
