On Thursday, August 2, a bus load of Hamilton Park UMC members visited the Dallas Art Museum for a private showing of the exhibit, "The Power of Gold." "The Power of Gold" showcases golden objects from the Asante people in Ghana.



In 1991 several African Americans in Dallas were enstooled in a ceremony at the Dallas Museum of Art by Nana Lartey Kwaku Esi II, who is the King of the Asona in Larteh, Akuapim, a state populated by Akan people. (King Lartey is the father of Rev. Lartey who once served as associate

pastor of Hamilton Park UMC.) The Dallasites were honored for their achievements and services rendered to the King. Our own Joe Nash was one of those honored to be enstooled. He was given the name Nana Out Ayebofo I.



Curator of the exhibit is Dr. Rosalind Walker, a member of St. Paul UMC. She spent four years researching and gathering each object.

Q & A PART 1 WITH REV. LISA BOZEMAN – "THE PARK'S" NEW INTERN

1. What was your childhood like?

God's prevenient grace has been throughout my life. My mother, the late Judge Lillie V. Mckenzie, by example, made sure that my siblings and I were in Sunday School and Church "ev'ry" Sunday. I attended head start/kindergarten in churches from the age of two until first grade. So, I was taught about God at school and at home...Along with Mom, there were other influential women like my kindergarten teachers, Mrs. Myrte Robinson, Mrs. Evelyn Holloway, Mother Betsy Weatherby and Mrs. Florine McCoy Bryant who encouraged me in the things of God and taught me to:

*"Trust in the LORD with all your (my) heart,
And do not rely on your (my) own insight.
In all your (my) ways acknowledge God,
And God will make straight your (my) paths."* –Proverbs 3: 5-6

2. What was your call to ministry like?

My call to ministry came from a personal encounter with God through God's Holy Spirit...I am forever grateful to those in helping me protect the call of God on my life, such as Dr. Warren H. Stewart, Sr., and the Pastor Tommy Barnette of Phoenix First, Pastors Cynthia and Saeed Hosseini; and Pastor W. Charles Bryant and the late Bishop Alexis A. Thomas for providing a place to exercise and operate in my call.

My assignment is comparable to Paul's charge to Timothy:

"I can't impress this on you too strongly. God is looking over your shoulder. Christ himself is the Judge, with the final say on everyone, living and dead. He is about to break into the open with his rule, so proclaim the Message (of the Gospel) with intensity; keep your watch. Challenge, warn, and urge your people. Don't ever quit. Just keep it simple." 2 Timothy 4: 1-2

3. What has your experience at Perkins been like?

Wow! My experience at Perkins (so far) has been absolutely like none other journey in my life...I have had some highs and quite a few lows...all of which have been transforming and God affirming. I know that I am here, at this time, *only* by the Grace of God!
