### A Standing Ovation for Dr. Claude Williams

On August 9, 2018, Dr. Claude Williams, a retired Captain of the United States Navy, was recognized as one of the Founders of the National Naval Officers Association at the 46th Annual Leadership and Training Symposium in Portsmouth, VA. NNOA was founded in 1972 in Annapolis, MD to improve minority interest in recruitment efforts and participation in the Naval Academy Blue and Gold Program.



In 1971, LT Kenneth Johnson, Capt. Emerson Emory, Capt. Claude Williams, CDR Emmanuel Jenkins and CWO James Harris began discussing the idea of forming the organization to assist minority officer recruitment. The first annual meeting was held in San Diego, CA in 1973. The first chartered chapter was the Annapolis, MD Chapter.

### Fighting sickle cell disease with "superhero" strength

Khadence Matthews encourages others to push through by using "superhero" strength. With her upbeat attitude and spunky energy, it would be hard for anyone to guess that "KK" has sickle cell anemia. At 3 years old, she began receiving monthly blood transfusions. Khadence explains that her treatments were the inspiration for her drawing, which is featured on the 2018 Children's Health Sickle Cell Awareness Month t-shirt. "Getting a transfusion is like having a superhero help you," she says. When asked if she feels like a superhero, too, she smiles and nods. Children's is honoring KK in a special way on Monday night. She will be introduced as a special fighter, *Diva Destroyer*, with her own intro music as she enters the ring, at the WWE Raw Wrestling event at the American Airlines Center in Dallas. This 10 year-old superhero is an amazing big sister to her 6 and 3 year-old sisters, Krissy and Khylie, and loves being involved with the Children's Ministry at The Park. With her determination, passion and persistent smile, Khadence is certainly a superhero for us all.
