On February 3<sup>rd</sup> Dr. Herman J. Felton, Jr., President of Wiley College, will be the guest speaker at the 10 am worship service.





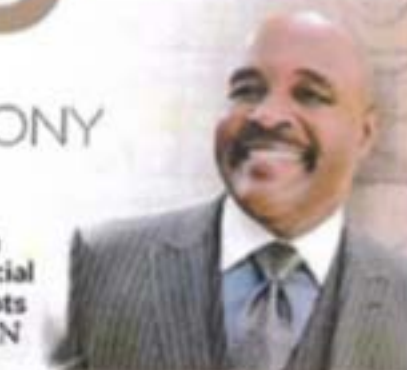
