Hamilton Park United Methodist Church Higher Education Ministry Scholarship Application

Purpose

The Hamilton Park United Methodist Church scholarship program exists to assist financially, those qualified individuals seeking to attend an accredited institution of higher learning. Most of the scholarships are awarded on the basis of local church participation and academic performance.

General Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be an **active** member (9th – 12th grades) of Hamilton Park United Methodist Church
- Must plan to attend a college, university, or seminary which is fully accredited by its regional accrediting association
- Must have established and maintained a satisfactory academic record, (above a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale).

Scholarship Program

The Hamilton Park United Methodist Church scholarship program is comprised of scholarships sponsored by various donors and church organizations:

Most scholarships range from \$250 - \$2,500.

In order to apply for one of the scholarships high school students must complete an application and the following requirements for individual scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded based on high school academic performance, activity within the church and qualifications of individual scholarships. Applications are due; **April 28, 2019**

Selection Criteria

1. Completed application submitted on or before **application deadline**
2. Active participation in Hamilton Park United Methodist Church – 9th through 12th grades
3. High School GPA
4. Community Service
5. 1 Recommendation Letter from a teacher or community leader addressed to Hamilton Park UMC Scholarship Committee
6. Individual scholarship requirements

All application packets must include:

- Individual documents for scholarships you are applying
- A copy of your **high school transcript** (unofficial will be accepted)

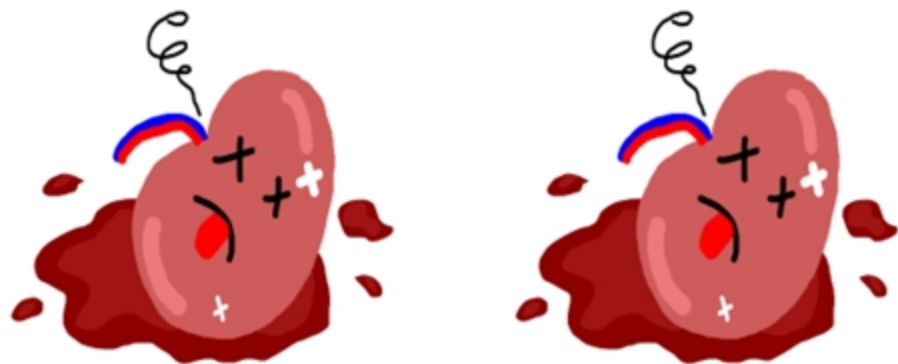
