

After September 15th, entries will be judged at the national level in the categories of literary art, performing art, visual art, instrumental art I (vocal art), and instrumental art II. This National Arts Competition will award \$5,000 in cash prizes to winners in each of five categories as follows: 1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$300, and 3rd Place \$200. Winners will be announced on *The Society, Incorporated - Supporting the Arts'* website and social media platforms.




