The Rev. Bryant X. Phelps June 11th @ 10:00 am



The Reverend Bryant X. Phelps is an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church and Senior Pastor of Church of the Disciple (a United Methodist Congregation) in DeSoto, Texas. Since his childhood, he has been committed to advancing communities through advocacy and service. A native of Midland, Texas, Rev. Phelps is a graduate of Morehouse College in Atlanta, GA (Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration) and Southern Methodist University (Master of Divinity), and is currently a doctoral student at Duke University School of Divinity.

Rev. Phelps' scholarship, service, public speaking, preaching, and lecturing have afforded him several opportunities. He has been honored for much of his work and because of his social impact, Rev. Phelps was honored with an endowed scholarship bearing his name with the United Negro College Fund in 2021. Every fall, students may apply for The Reverend Bryant X. Phelps Endowed Scholarship.

A man of faith and service, Rev. Phelps' connectional leadership consists of membership on the Metro District Committee on Ministry and the North Texas Annual Conference Committee of Finance and Administration, and he is the Vice Chair for the North Texas Caucus of Black Methodists for Church Renewal. Reflecting a lifetime of service, he is also a member of several organizations that are dedicated to social service and advocacy.

Bryant is married to Mrs. Courtney Phelps, his Spelman College sweetheart, who is the Director of Community Service Learning at The Episcopal School of Dallas. Together, they are the parents of one daughter, Hailey.

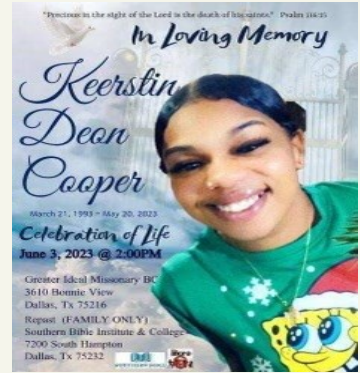
