

Book Signing This Sunday in The CLC



Dr. Joel Nwoke, a long-time member of Hamilton Park United Methodist Church, has recently published a new book on domestic violence. Titled "Domestic

Violence Among Sub-Saharan African Immigrants," the book is based on Dr. Nwoke's experience in conflict resolution and anger management.

"I resolve domestic violence situations daily in my anger management classes. It occurs amongst many Sub-Saharan African immigrants because their communities and families are not with them. Studies have shown that when we reside with our extended families, we tend to find peaceful resolutions to working out problems in the home."



Dr. Nwoke is an experienced social worker with a demonstrated history working in the hospital & healthcare industry. He is also skilled in Healthcare Management, Crisis Intervention, Medical Social

Work, and Group Therapy.

He holds a bachelor's degree in social work from Texas A&M Commerce, a master's degree in social work from the University of Texas in Arlington, and a Doctorate in Social Work from Capella University.

Dr. Nwoke is married to Dr. Gertrude Nwoke, and together, they have five children. At The Park, Dr. Nwoke is also a strong member of the Afro-Park Families.



Losing Medicaid or CHIP?

3 Things to know



During the COVID-1s pandemic, states were able to stop reviewing eligibility for Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance. Program (CHP), and couldn't remove anyone who was enrolled in this coverage. As of February 1, 2023, states are allowed to restart those reviews. This means some adults and children may lose their Medicaid or CHP coverage.

If your state tells you that you've lost or may soon lose health coverage through Medicald or CHIP, you have other health care options. Here are 3 important things to know:

- You can re-apply for Medicaid
 or CHIP to find out if you still
 qualify
- In all states, Medicaid and CHIP offer health coverage to some low-income people, families and children, pregnant women, the elderly, and people with disabilities. If your income level or medic needs change, you might qualify for Medicaid or CHIP in your state.
- You can apply any time, and there's no limit to the number of times you can
- To re-apply for Medicaid or CHIP, visit Medicaid.gov/about-us/beneficiaryresources/index.html#statemenu as find your state for next steps.
- cost, quality health coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace*.
- Most people qualify for savings on a health plan to lower their monthly premium and what they pay when they get care. Savings are based on household income and size.
- All Marketplace plans cover doctor visits, prescription drugs, emergency care, mental health, hospitalizations, and more.
- Visit HealthCare.gov to find and enroll in a health plan, or call the Marketplace Call Center at 1-800-318-2596.

 TTY users can call 1-855-889-4325.
- Submit a new or updated Marketplace application to see if you for other members of your household; qualify to enroll in a Marketplace plan and get help with costs.
- Medicare without paying a late enrollment penalty.

 If you now qualify for Medicare, but didn't sign up for it when you first became eligible, you have a limited time (called a "Special Enrollment Period") to sign up without paying the usual penalty.
- Your Special Enrofiment Period starts the day your state notifies you that your Medicaid coverage is ending, and continues for 6 months after your Medicaid coverage ends.
- To sign up for Medicare during this Special Errollment Period, fill out a CMS-10797 form and mail or fault to your local Social Security office. Vocan elso call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213. TTY users can call 1-800-325-0778.
