

February is American Heart Month

Heart Attack, Stroke and Cardiac Arrest Symptoms

If these warning signs are present CALL 911 Heart Attack Symptoms

CHEST DISCOMFORT

Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

DISCOMFORT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE UPPER BODY

Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.

SHORTNESS OF BREATH

with or without chest discomfort.

OTHER SIGNS

may include breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea or lightheaded-ness.

Stroke Symptoms

It is to showcase the vibrant African American history of North Dallas. Visitors will be guided through a captivating exhibition that highlights the significant events and individuals that have influenced the development of North Dallas, particularly District 11. The exhibition will be displayed throughout the months of February and March. The conference room will be dedicated to the late Dr. George E. Keaton, founder of Remembering Black Dallas and historian. There will be a ribbon cutting for the conference room.

Spot a stroke F.A.S.T. FACE DROOPING

Does one side of the face droop or is it numb? Ask the person to smile.

ARM WEAKNESS

Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?

SPEECH DIFFICULTY

Is speech slurred, are they unable to speak, or are they hard to understand? Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence, like "the sky is blue." Is the sentence repeated correctly?

TIME TO CALL 911

If the person shows any of these symptoms, even if the symptoms go away, call 911 and get them to the hospital immediately.

Cardiac Arrest Symptoms

SUDDEN LOSS OF RESPONSIVENESS

No response to tapping on shoulders.

NO NORMAL BREATHING

The victim does not take a normal breath when you tilt the head up and check for at least five seconds

<u>Iwvtx.clubexpress.com/votebymail</u> which has some very helpful videos for how to fill out an application and also how to complete a ballot by mail.






