#### Celebrating the Life

Scypion Jamaal Goodin, affectionately known as "Sip" to family and friends, was born the oldest of two sons to the union of Andrew and Pamela Goodin on September 17, 1978, in Decatur, Alabama. When Scypion was five years old, the family moved to Dallas, Texas where his younger brother was born.

Scypion gave his life to Christ at an early age, leading the way down the aisle with the family in tow joining Hamilton Park United Methodist Church in November 1988. Scypion and the family were baptized (by immersion) in April 1989. Scypion was regularly active in the church as a youth. He completed the Confirmation Class, sang in the choir, and was often called upon to sing solos. Scypion was an acolyte for many years and was a member of the church Boy Scout Troop 573.

Scypion's early childhood education was in the Richardson Independent School District where he honed his baseball skills and developed a passion for music. The family later moved to Carrollton, Texas where Scypion attended Newman Smith High School. Later,he attended TJC in Tyler, Texas where his love for music continued. Scypion always had a passion for helping others, so he later decided to become a Certified Massage Therapist.

Scypion began in the music industry by writing songs and making beats. He is known as "Icewater" with many songs like "One of a Kind" on Spotify and other music platforms.

He was preceded in death by his only son, Kier Solomon; his maternal grandfather, Robert Carson; his paternal grandparents Henry and Eva Mae Goodin; two aunts Julia Shaw and Patricia Williams; five uncles Eddie Paul Goodin, Edward Goodin, Walter Goodin, Silas Goodin, and Victor Jackson.


